WHAT 2023 HELD FOR US

Last year, 2023, was a unique year for Shiawassee Hope! Our primary area of support is in Pleasant Valley, where our impact center is located.

We experienced a detrimental storm in September and had to work together to get funding to support the residents in Pleasant Valley. With funding and donated time, we were able to help families rebuild.

We continue to provide weekly Tuesday night dinners to connect and build community. Additionally, we have volunteers come out weekly to provide reading and therapeutic supports.

We continued to do our annual back to school party with school supplies & backpacks donated. And we also continued to do our annual Christmas Store!
